

## MRS. A. G. HICKS DIES MONDAY

## Lifelong Resident Of City In Failing Health— Funeral Thursday

Mrs. Clyde Hicks, age 88, widow of A. G. Hicks, well known photographer, of Franklin, died at her apartment, 115½ East Jefferson Monday night at 11:30 o'clock.

Funeral services will be held from the Flinn Funeral Home, Thursday morning at 10 o'clock. The Rev. Fred Young will be in charge of the services, with burial in Greenlawn cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home Wednesday afternoon and Wednesday evening from 7 to 9.

Mrs. Hicks was born in Franklin in 1857, the daughter of Nathanal and Margaret Hord Jackson. She was married to A. G. Hicks, who for many years was one of the best known photographers in Indiana.
