PUBLIC DEBT
OF THE LATE
REPUBLIC OF TEXAS.

This is to Certify, THAT G. A. Pettifrain has, under the provisions of an act of the LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, entitled "An Act to provide for ascertaining the Debt of the late Republic of Texas," approved 20th March, 1843, filed with the Auditor and Comptroller A. Clair for paying the Brig Wharton in 1842 from sea to New Orleans

amounting to Three hundred & twenty five Dollars; which is sufficiently authenticated to authorize the auditing of the same under the laws of the late Republic of Texas.

The said claim, according to the data before us, is reduced to Twenty five dollars, in par funds, as having been, at that rate so available to the Government.
